Health Planning – “The Seven Ds”

1. Discuss ... the process
2. Design ... the workplan
3. Discover ... the current situation
4. Define ... the priorities
5. Develop ... the draft
6. Deliver ... the plan
7. Do ... the work





1. Discuss ... the process

- Engage with leadership
- Establish a guiding/planning group
 - Clear governance
 - Terms of Reference
 - Roles, responsibilities, reporting
- Communicate
- Linking with Comprehensive Community Plan (if you have one)





2. Design ... the workplan

Create a workplan that includes:

- All the activities (steps)
- Who is responsible
- Realistic timelines
- Who needs to be involved and how





3. Discover...the current situation

- Review your previous Health Plan
 - What's been done? What hasn't been done? Why not?
 - Mandatory programs/Health Promotion programs
 - Identify resources
 - Identify needs

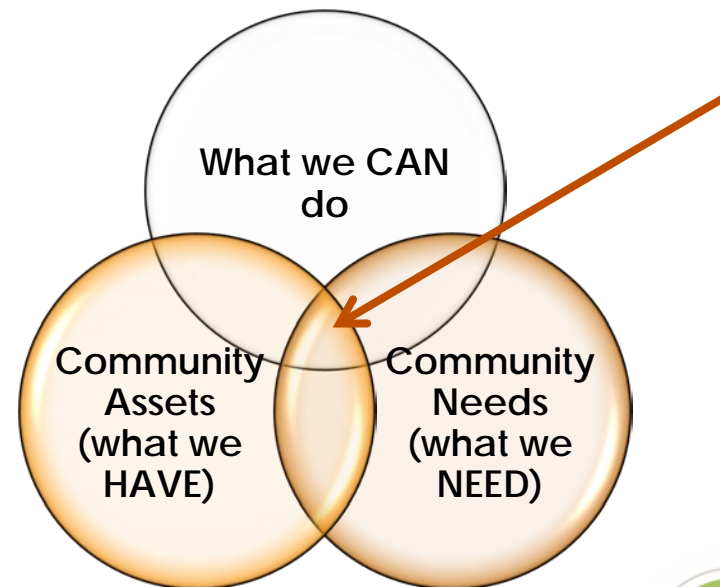




4. Define ... the priorities

Can't do everything, have to create a way to prioritize the needs.

- What do we have?
- What do we need?
- What **CAN** we do?





5. Develop ... the draft

- Describe how you created your Health Plan (who was involved and how, what activities you held, what documents were used, how decisions were made, how messages were communicated)
- Describe community – (resources, needs)
- Outline priorities, five-year goals, key strategies
- Describe how mandatory programs/health promotion programs help achieve goals
- Describe human resource needs
- Describe infrastructure needs
- Outline the evaluation plan





6. Deliver ... the plan

- Share with leadership group for approval and sign-off
- Communicate with staff
- Submit to funder
- Keep community informed
- Share with relevant partners and stakeholders





7. Do ... the work

- Identify any specific implementation requirements
- Identify specific training requirements
- Create an Annual Plan
 - Implement
 - Monitor
 - Evaluate
